1	bathroom	/ˈbæθ ruːm/	A room with a bath or shower and often a toilet.
2	bedroom	/'bɛdruːm/	A room for sleeping
3	dining-room	/ˈdaɪnɪŋ ruːm/	A room for eating
4	kitchen	/ˈkɪtʃɪn/	A room for making food
5	living-room	/ˈlɪvɪŋ ruːm/	The main room in the house it is often where people relax
6	staircase	/'steəkeis/	A number of stairs that allow people to go from one floor to another
7	study	/ˈstʌdɪ/	a room Where people do homework and office work

1	armchair	/aːmt∫ɛə/	Where one person can sit comfortably
2	bed	/bɛd/	Used for sleeping
3	bookcase	/ˈbʊkkeɪs/	Where people put books
4	CD Player	/six dix 'pleɪə/	Used to play CDs. (Compact Discs)
5	desk	/dɛsk/	A place to sit and write
6	DVD Player	/diː viː diː ˈpleɪə/	Used to play DVDs (Digital Versatile Discs)
7	kitchen sink	/ˈkɪtʃɪn sɪŋk/	Used to wash things
8	laptop	/læp top/	A type of computer that is portable
9	light	/laɪt/	Used to create light after dark. (Also verb)
10	pool table	/puːl ˈteɪbl/	Used for playing pool
11	sofa	/ˈsəʊfə/	Where two – four people can sit comfortably
12	stove	/stəʊv/	Used for boiling and steaming
13	table	/'teɪbl/	Used for eating and putting things
14	phone	/fəʊn/	Used to talk to people
15	TV	/tiːˈviː/	Allows people to watch moving images
