

Rules for Plural pronunciation

(Can also be used for regular present tense third person verbs)

Voiced consonants & vowels

/b/ /d/ /g/ /l/ /m/ /n/ /r/ /v/ /w/ /z/ /ð/ (clo**th**es)

Plural is /z/ e.g. Pens, Cars, plays & legs

Unvoiced consonants

 $/p//t//k//f//\theta//t/$

Plural is /s/ e.g. Bags, plants, tents & backs

Except Sibilants

/s/ /z/ /ʃ/ /ʒ/ /tʃ/

Plural is: /IZ/ e.g.

Watches, kisses, wishes & boxes
